

Bucks County Trail

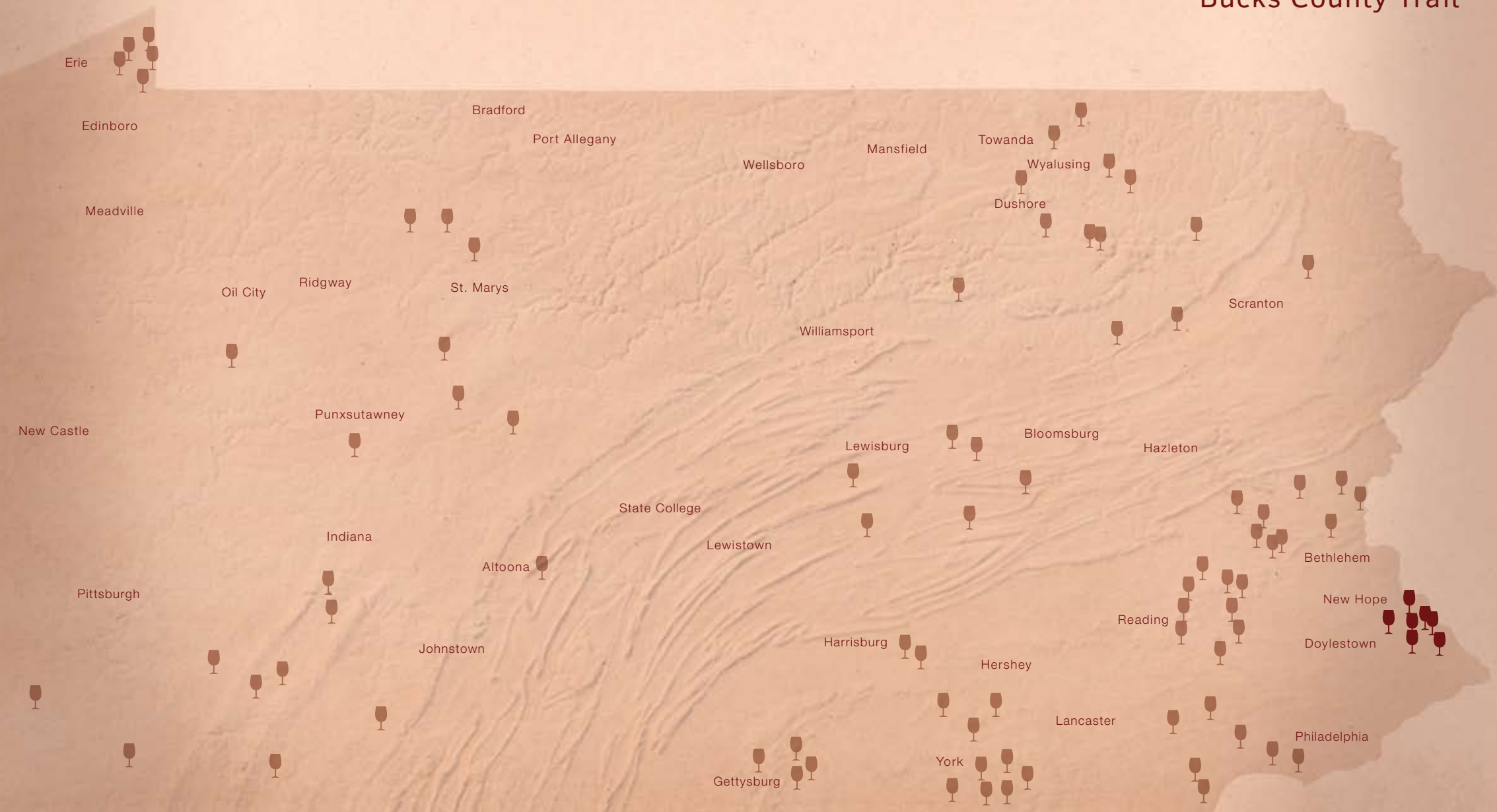
